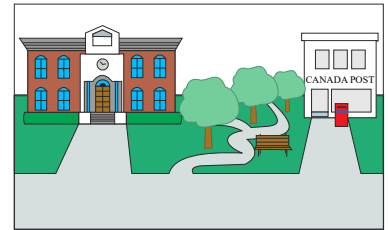

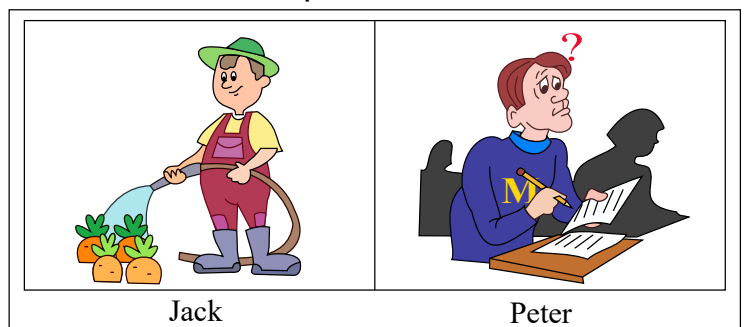

19 Anemia

If there are too few red cells in a person's blood, they may have a disease called anemia. Red blood cells are important because they carry oxygen all over the body. Some people with anemia have fewer than normal red blood cells. Others have red cells that do not work correctly.

Many different medical problems can cause, or create, anemia. Some types of anemia are genetic diseases (handed down from parent to child). A genetic disease may change the shape of red blood cells or their size. Some bacteria or viruses can stop the body from making enough red blood cells. An unhealthy diet – especially one low in iron, folic acid or vitamin B12– can also keep the body from making enough red blood cells. Some drugs can also damage or destroy red cells. Finally, people sometimes lose blood (and therefore red blood cells) in an injury, for example, which can cause anemia.

The symptoms, or signs, of anemia are different based on the type of the disease. Doctors usually identify anemia with simple blood tests.
